Entity's Purpose or Mission

The primary objective of the Club is to promote, develop and deliver Surf Life Saving as a charitable service and prevent drowning and injury of those swimming and undertaking activities at beaches and other aquatic environments by providing lifesaving, patrol services and other programmes and services at Titahi Beach and at other locations as determined by the Club for the safety and recreation of the general public.

Entity Structure

Club Management Structure: Our constitution governance structure allows for up to 13 officers with a management committee of 10 including an executive committee of Chairperson, Treasurer, Secretary and Club Captain. Committee roles are unpaid.

Operational Structure: The club's operations are managed by the officers of the management committees area of responsibility overseen by the executive committee. The club does not have any paid employees where it relies on its members and volunteers to support us with the various activities throughout the year. Except when grant funds become available for youth development where a part-time coach may be employed on a fixed term contract.

Main Sources of Entity's Cash and Resources

Charitable grants, club membership fees, donations, government funding, interest, social activities, club merchandise sales, limited fundraising.

Main Methods Used by Entity to Raise Funds

Limited fund raising activities to support the purchase of a new paddle boards for competition and an IRB engine for patrols.

Entity's Reliance on Volunteers and Donated Goods or Services

Each committee member donates on average 100 hours of their time per year to work on Governance matters and provide support to the club members and volunteers relating to their various roles. Non-committee volunteers donate on average 40 hours per year of their time to support the club with various activities relating to Surf Life Saving in the area.

Members

We have 170 under 14 members, 124 Associate members, 85 Lifeguards each volunteering 12.32 hours on average for beach patrolling, including 16 new lifeguards.

With 389 members in total, we are able to provide lifesaving, patrol services and other programmes and services at Titahi Beach and at other locations for the safety and recreation of the general public.

Committee members time

Roughly 900 hours over the year or about 100 hours per committee member although workload varies between roles and positions.

Statement of Accounting Policies

Titahi Bay Surf Life Saving Club Incorporated For the year ended 30 June 2024

'How did we do our accounting?'

Basis of Preparation

The entity has elected to apply PBE SFR-A (NFP) Public Benefit Entity Simple Format Reporting - Accrual (Not-For-Profit) on the basis that it does not have public accountability and has total annual expenses equal to or less than \$2,000,000. All transactions in the Performance Report are reported using the accrual basis of accounting. The Performance Report is prepared under the assumption that the entity will continue to operate in the foreseeable future.

Donations

Donations are recognised as revenue upon receipt and include donations from regular donors.

Grants

Grants received are recognised as revenue, unless there are unfulfilled conditions attached to the grant. In these cases, the grant is treated as a liability until the conditions are fulfilled

Depreciation

Depreciation was calculated at rates appropriate for the asset varying from 5% Diminishing Value for Land & Buildings and 22% to 40% Diminishing Value for Plant & Equipment for the year.

Bank Accounts and Cash

Bank accounts and cash in the Statement of Cash Flows comprise cash balances and bank balances (including short term deposits) with maturities of 12 months or less.

Debtors

Debtors are stated at their net realisable value.

Goods and Services Tax

The entity is registered for Goods and Services Tax. All amounts are stated exclusive of goods and services tax except for accounts payable and accounts receivable which are stated inclusive of Goods and Services Tax. Grant and Donation income is not subject to Goods and Services Tax.

Income Tax

Titahi Bay Surf Life Saving Club has charitable status and is wholly exempt from New Zealand income tax having fully complied with all statutory conditions for these exemptions.

Property, Plant & Equipment

Property, Plant & Equipment are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. Where an asset is disposed of, the gain or loss recognised in the Statement of Financial Performance is calculated as the difference between the sale price and the carrying amount of the asset.

Investments

Investments are included at cost.
